- 1.6 The Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training to the students of Golaghat Commerce College.



(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')


WHEREAS:



IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES MADE AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE PROJECT, THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AGREED UPON ARE NOW BEING PUT ON RECORD THROUGH THIS MOU.

1. Both Parties agree to open a program of Post Graduate Diploma in Tea Plantation Management. This will be a one- year training program in Tea Plantation Management comprising of two semesters.
2. In order to facilitate the program, 1st party shall provide the necessary class room and other infrastructural facility.
3. This diploma course will be a joint collaboration of Centre for Tea Plantation Management (CTPM) which is under the administration of Principal, Golaghat Commerce College and North Eastern Tea Association.
