1. Celebration of World Environment Day



Students of Golaghat Commerce College participated in a social media campaign to save Dehing Patkai, the only rainforest in Assamand raised awareness against illegal coal mining.




13.Webinar on "Awareness for Revival and Conservation of Ecosystems"


