At the initiative of Equal Opportunity Cell, **An Awareness Programme was organized on Eradication of Social Evils and Legal Awareness in Rural Society** on 29th June, 2017 at Teteliguri, Gomariguri, Golaghat. The programme was attended by the villagers of Teteliguri and the staff of Golaghat Commerce College. The program commenced with a welcome address delivered by Mr. Biswajyoti Doley, Convenor of Equal Opportunity Cell in which he highlighted the importance of organising such a programme and addressed the issue of prevalence of witch hunting and witchcraft in North East India. Following him, Dr. Jatindra Nath Saikia, Principal, Golaghat Commerce College too welcomed the audience He stated the urgency of organising this programme in rural places where witch hunting largely takes place. He maintained that the lack of proper education among indigenous people and the government's failure to provide required aids can be considered two of the primary reasons behind the birth of such a heinous crime. Mr. Jadav Mech, Secretary District Legal Services Authority in his speech shared multiple stories of witch hunting from Assam. He stressed on the fact that laws against witch hunting are not enough to curb its prevalence. He emphasized that witch hunting can be completely eradicated only by collective efforts of both common people and the law. Mr. Nitul Bora, Golaghat Bar Association in his speech focused on the roles educational institutions can play in abolition of the practice of witch-hunting. The faculty members and the local villagers also shared their experiences and interacted with the distinguished Resource Persons. The vote of thanks was delivered by Mr. Bhaskar Kakati, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science.


Executive Summary:

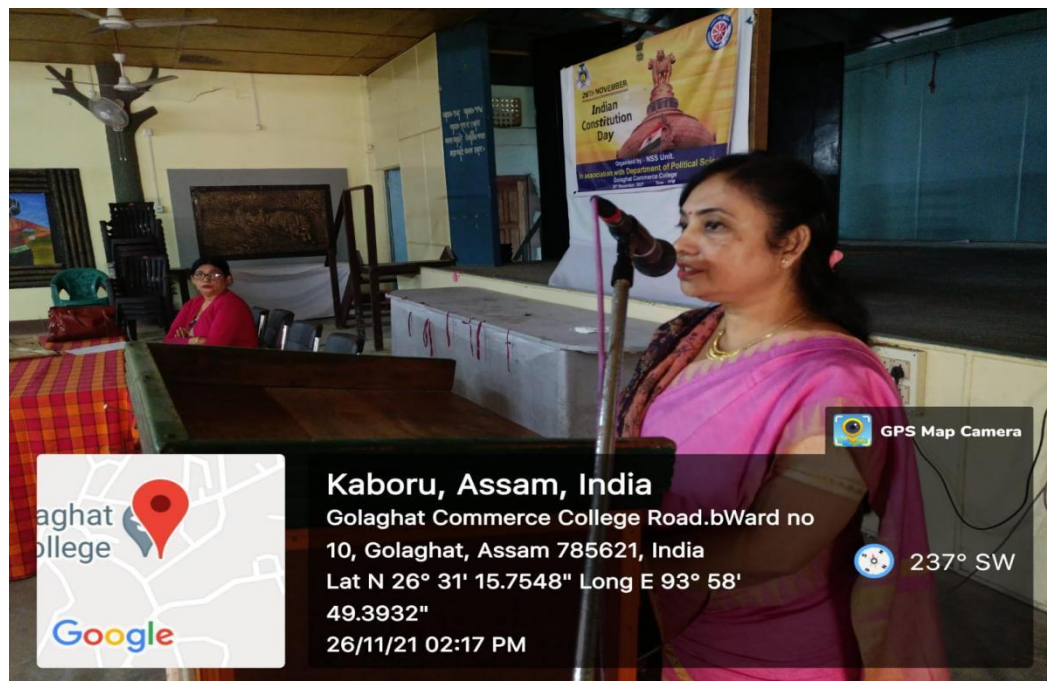


