Highlights of the Academic Year

shared their views on different aspects of the budget. The seminar ended with the vote of thanks by Julee Dutta, Assistant professor of the Department.

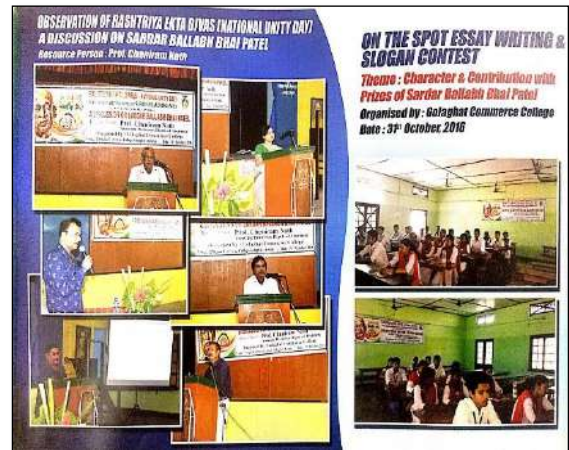
UGC Sponsored National Seminar on Rural Financing in North Eastern Region of India: Issues and Challenges:

Rashtriya Ekta Divas (National Unity Day): Rashtriya Ekta Divas (National Unity Day) was celebrated on 31st October, 2016.



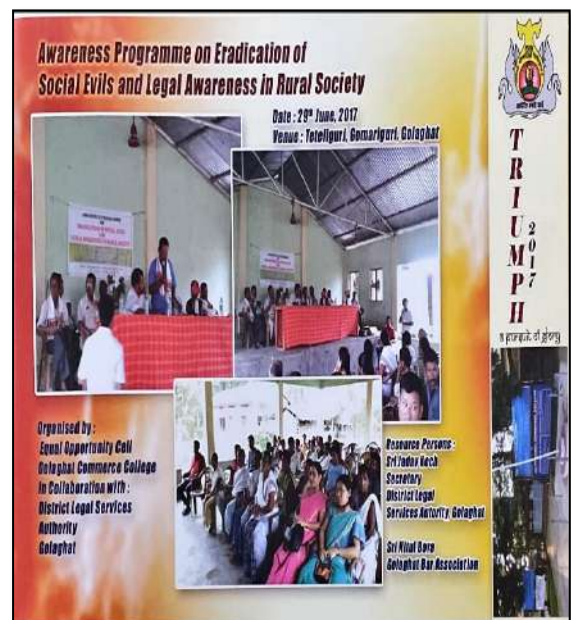
International Mother Language Day: International Mother Language Day was celebrated on 21st February, 2017,

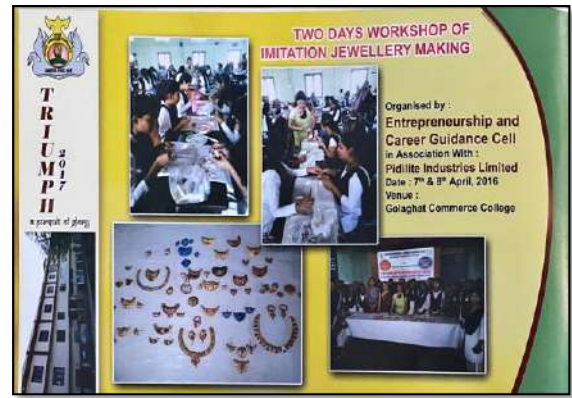

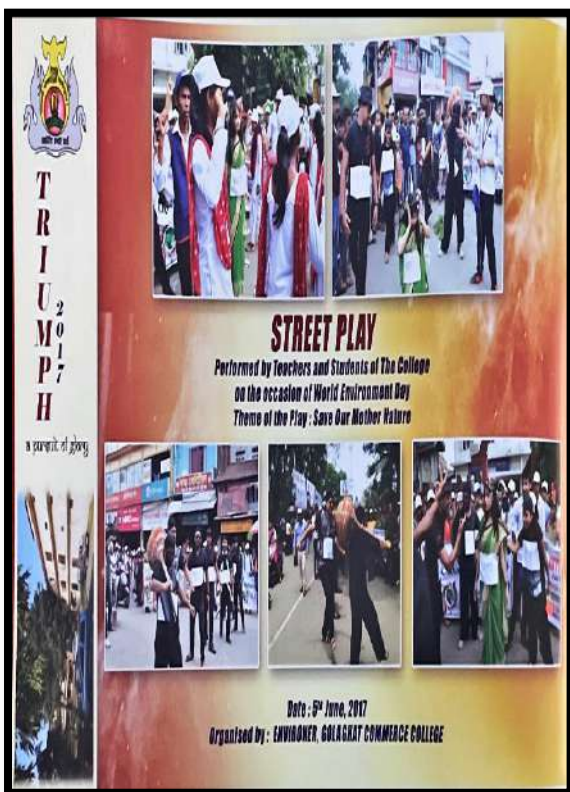
