## Impact of Regionalism on Indian Politics:

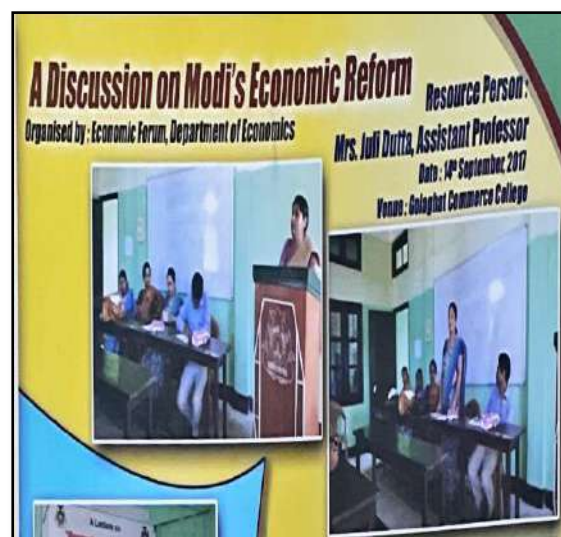

executive member NETA, Mr. ManojJallan, Director Golaghat Tea Estate, Mr. Kamal Buzarbaruah, VC, Assam Agricultural University, Mr. Bijay Gopal Chakrabarty, Chairman, All India Small Tea Growers Association were also present in the seminar.

Teaching staff of the Institution were encouraged to attend the seminar and 32 teachers from the college attended the seminar.
