

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

REGARDING TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

This Memorandum of Understanding Regarding Transportation Services is entered into between Golaghat Commerce College (the First Party) and the E- Rickshaw Association, Golaghat, Assam (the Second Party) with the parties agreeing as follows:

1. The second party agrees to provide safe and convenient transportation to the students of Golaghat Commerce College which will be made available for commuting from Golaghat bus stand to the college from Monday to Saturday.

2. Both the parties agree at a reasonable fare to be paid by the students availing the transportation service.

3. Either party may revoke this Memorandum of Understanding at any time by providing written notice to the other party.
