CONCEPT NOTE
Pi (π), the 16th letter of the Greek alphabet, is used to represent the most widely known mathematical constant, which is the ratio of the circumference of a circle to its diameter. No matter how large or small a circle is, π will always work out to be the same number. Because it's most elementary definition relates to the circle, π is found in many formulas in trigonometry and geometry, especially those concerning circles, ellipses, and spheres.

π occurs in various mathematical problems involving the lengths of arcs or other curves, the areas of ellipses, sectors, and other curved surfaces, and the volumes of many solids. It is also used in various formulae of physics and engineering to describe periodic phenomena such as the motion of pendulums, the vibration of strings, and alternating electric currents. The ubiquity of π makes it one of the most widely known mathematical constants both inside and outside the scientific community.
