Identification of Problems and Action Taken Report:

In order to deal with the slow learners, focus had been directed to eliciting specific deterrent factors of individual students. Some slow learners were found to be lacking in critical reading and understanding of texts. Some others were not competent in either reading or writing. Quite a few students were also found to be passive listeners having poor retention capacity. Attempts had been made to develop critical reading skills among the students by demonstrating how a text (prescribed in their syllabus) can be critically interpreted in different ways. They were also given tips on developing writing skills such as using simple words and grammatically correct short sentences. Attempts had also been made to make them

familiar with the techniques of developing active listening skills and strengthening their retention capacity. By encouraging them to interact in the class room and involving them in group discussions and panel discussions, attempts were made to develop their communicative skills.

- Special classes on Basic English Grammar were held to develop their grammar skills.
- Family issues deterring students were dealt with very carefully through counseling sessions held whenever necessary.
- Students having expertise in extra-curricular activities were referred to Physical Education Department for seamless progression.
- Advanced learners were assigned extra works such as analyzing texts from interdisciplinary perspectives, developing academic writing skills, etc.
- The progress of students is measured through their performance in Sessional Examinations, Seminar Presentation, Group Discussion and their interaction in the class.
