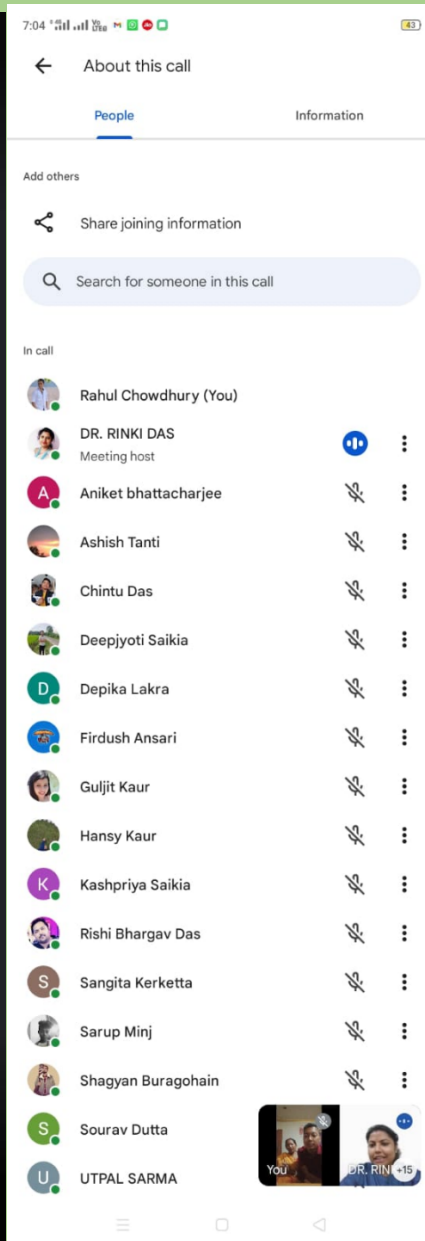
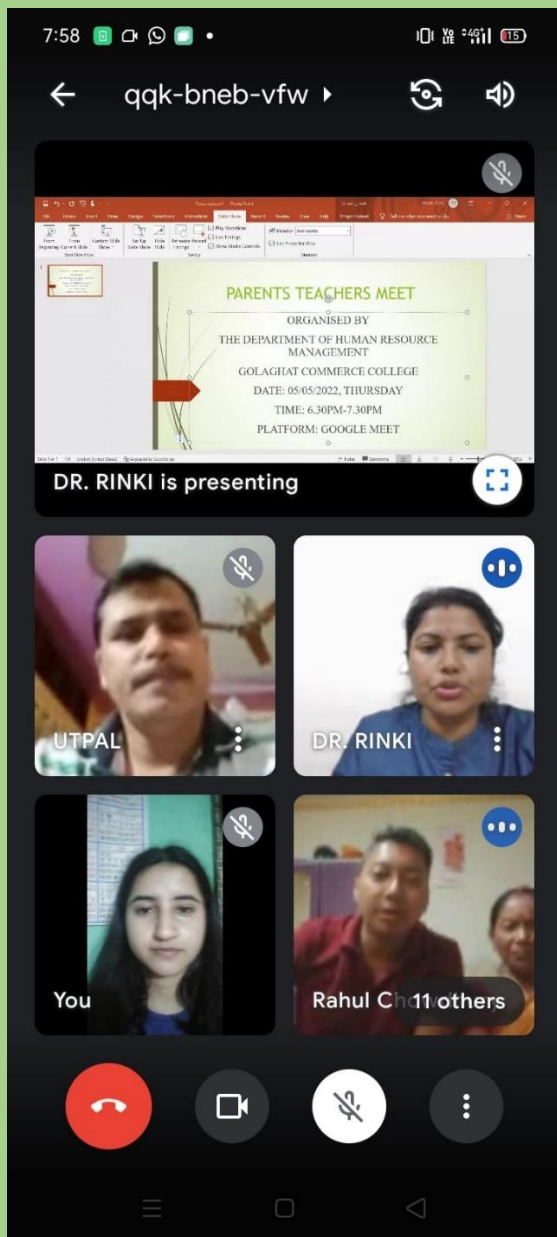
**Meeting Agenda:**

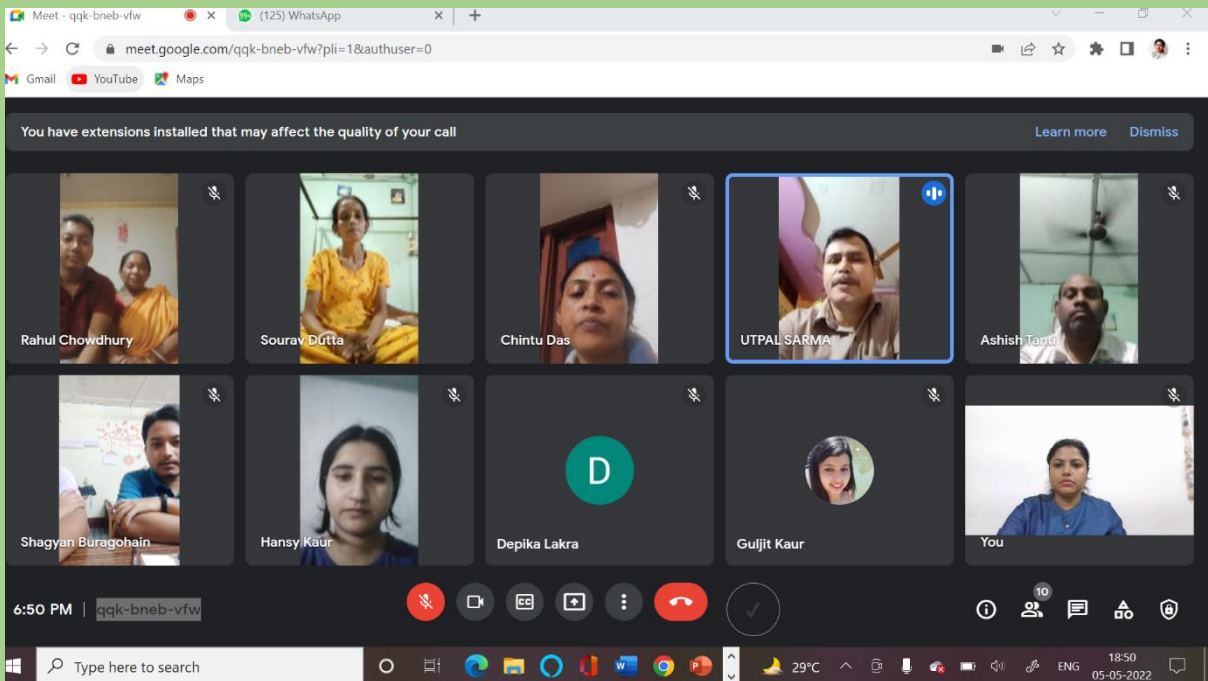
- **To have an introduction among the Parents/ Guardians and Departmental Teachers and College Authority i.e., Principal of the College**

- **To aware the guardians about the scope of improvement of their respective wards.**


