TWO DAYS NATIONAL SEMINAR ORGANISED BY THE

Two Days National Seminar in online mode titled 'New Education Policy (2020) and its focus on skill development' has been organized by the Department of Human Resource Management on the Google meet platform, on March 11 and 12, 2023 in collaboration with the Kolkata Bidhannagar Society for Academic Advancement (KBSAA), West Bengal. The inauguration program was hosted by Dr. Rinki Das, Assistant Professor and Head of the department of HRM and Prof. Jadab Krishna Das, Professor, Dept. of Commerce, University of Calcutta gave the inaugural address. A special address was given by Dr. Utpal Sarma, Principal, of Golaghat Commerce College along with Dr. Pranjal Pratim Dutta, IQAC Coordinator of the college. A special address was given by Pema Lama, Associate Professor, at Calcutta University and Secretary of Kolkata Bidhannagar Society for Academic Advancement.

The paper presenters were mostly UG and PG students across the country and they tried their best to discuss various sub-topics relevant to New Education Policy. Most of the topics suggested their findings on how vocational, skill-based, and blended modes in NEP will impact the future education system of India. The discussion was very fruitful with the academicians focused on the constraints and prospects of NEP.

The seminar ended successfully with the constant participation of the organizing committee as well as the resource persons and paper presenters.
