Mr. Rajesh Jaiswal introduced the Union Budget 2023-24 among the students with the Vision for '**Amrit Kaal**' as articulated in the Union Budget . He explained the seven priorities, termed Saptarishi, adopted in the Union Budget for FY 2023-24 to guide the country towards '**Amrit Kaal**', thus providing a blueprint for an empowered and inclusive economy. He spoke about the different schemes and opportunities that the Government has planned for the year 2023-24.

Mr. Atul Kumar Das gave a highlight of the State Budget: Assam, 2023-24. He structurally analysed the total expenditure of Rs. 1, 35,438 crores for the year 2023-24 and its linkage with economic development. The resource person observed that the State Budget to be “Developmental and people connecting”.
