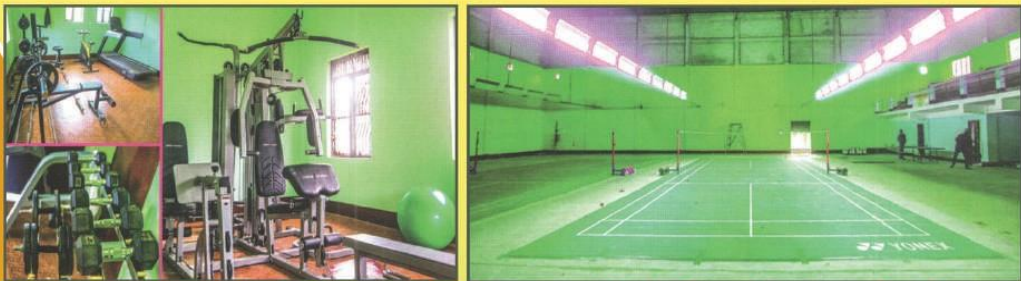

Golaghat Commerce College : A Profile

The Golaghat Commerce College, a premier institution of commerce education in the district of Golaghat, came into existence in 1972. The college, with its picturesque location, is situated in the outskirts of the sleepy little town of Golaghat. It was in fact the brainchild of its founder Principal, Late Punaram Neog. He along with some other visionary social workers belonging to different spheres of the society, felt the emerging pressure of acute unemployment in the state which was gradually leading to the wastage of valuable human resources on one hand and economic instability and social unrest in the society on the other. They had the foresight to realize that unless some entrepreneurs, who can not only ensure self employment for themselves, but can also employ some others in the enterprises, are produced, the problem of unemployment and resulting decay of rural economy might give birth to subversive ideas in the minds of the youth, which in turn can lead to social disintegration. Thus, basically with a view to boosting the rural economy of the district by producing a group of entrepreneurs and employable commerce graduates for a few government as well as private jobs available at that time, the college was initially established only with the donations of the public and was rightly christened as Golaghat Commerce College to send the message that it was a people's college- the college of the people of Golaghat.

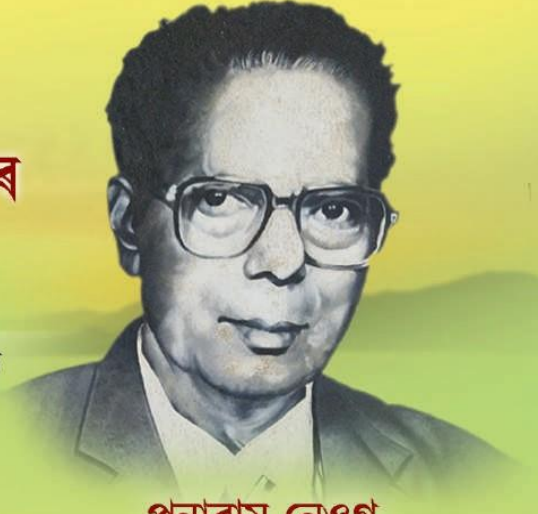

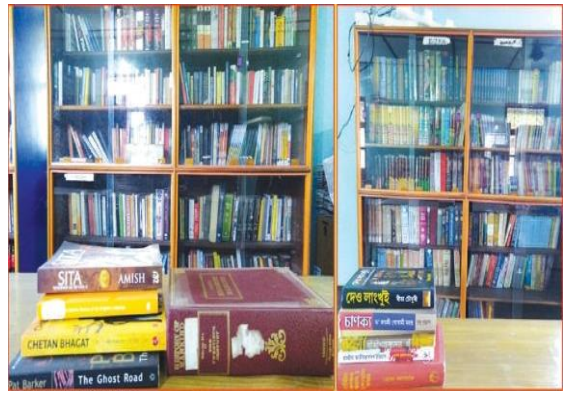

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A. HOW TO OBTAIN PROSPECTUS:

B. SUBMISSION OF FORMS:

The duly filled up form should be submitted allowing with the following documents:

C. RESERVATION POLICY:

Golaghat Commerce College strictly follows the reservation policy framed by the Government of Assam. Following is the detail guideline issued by the Government vide notification Govt. O.M. No. AHE.250/2014/1 dated 05/06/2014.

D. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

1. The admission into the college is made strictly on the basis of merit and is governed by the college admission rules. The admission committee's decision regarding admission is final and binding.
2. Any pressure or interference from any quarter for the admission of a particular student will result in a forfeiture of the claim.

E. SELECTION LIST:

1. The admission committee shall prepare a list of selected students representing all categories of applicants and the list will be displayed in the college notice-board and college website.
2. When the number of applicants exceeds the seat capacity, the admission committee may prepare a waiting list.

F. LAST DATE OF ADMISSION:

The admission committee shall fix and notify the last date of admission into the various courses.

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G. FILLING UP THE VACANT SEATS (if any):

After the last date of admission, if any seat remains vacant, it will be filled up from the applicants named in the waiting list. This will also be on the basis of merit.

H. ADMISSION COMMITTEE:

The admission committee consists of the Principal, Vice-Principal and a few faculty members.

I. COMMENCEMENT OF CLASSES:

The date of commencement of classes will be as per the directions of Assam Higher Secondary Education Council and Dibrugarh University.

J. SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR MAJORS:

Students seeking Major/Speciality in different subjects will be selected on the basis of Merit/Selection Test

K. HOSTEL ADMISSION (BOYS & GIRLS):

Students seeking admission in hostel must apply for hostel seat in a prescribed form available in the college office. The hostel management committee will make a selection of students for hostel admission on different criteria fixed by the committee.

GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE

1. Discipline among the students is the prime necessity for the all-round development of the college.
2. Students are responsible for their conduct and manners to the Principal, teachers and office staff. A student will be liable to disciplinary action by way of warning, fine, suspension and expulsion from the college for violation of college's rules and discipline.
3. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Students and their parents must give an undertaking at the time of admission. (Please go through the Anti-Ragging measures adopted by the college. They are available in the prospectus.)
4. Students should take proper care of the college property.
5. Consumption of Alcohol, Drugs, smoking and taking of gutkhas inside the college campus are strictly prohibited.

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6. Bi-cycles, scooters or motor cycles shall be parked in the parking area.
7. No organisation can be formed in the college without the permission of principal.
8. No student is allowed to wear hats and caps within the college campus.
9. Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited inside the college classrooms. A penalty of Rs.1000 will be imposed against the mobile users inside the classrooms.

COLLEGE IDENTITY CARD:

An identity card is issued to every student and they must possess it distinctly during college hours.

COLLEGE UNIFORM:

The college uniform is black trousers and white shirt and black sweater (in winter) for boys. The uniform for girls is white saree/chadar-mekhela with red border and red blouse or formal white salwar and pyjama with red Jaipuri print dupatta.

Short kurti leggings and jeans will not be allowed. (For girls)

T-Shirt and jeans will not be allowed (For boys)

No student will be allowed to attend the classes without proper uniform.

ATTENDANCE:

A student who has less than 80% attendance in average shall not be permitted to sit for the End-semester examination.

However, that it shall be open to the University to grant exemption to a student who has attended a minimum of 70% classes but failed to obtain the prescribed 80% attendance for valid reasons, on recommendation of the Head/Chairperson/Principals of the Department/Centre/College on payment of a prescribed fee(s).

FACILITIES OFFERED

1. COLLEGE LIBRARY:

The college library of Golaghat Commerce College, popularly known as 'Chinta-Taranga Chora', is an integral part of academic excellence of the college. The library has its own repute in terms of books, journals, services, e-resources and other related conventional and unconventional activities. At present, the library has a stock of approx. 21,000 text-books and reference books and more than 25 newspapers and periodicals, e-books and e-journals. The college has access to many on line journals and also connected to N-List library facilities supported by Govt of India.

2. HOSTEL FACILITIES:

The college has hostel facilities for both boys and girls. In view of the limited number of seats available, the hostel seats are allotted strictly on the basis of merit. To avail hostel facilities, a student should apply for hostel seats in separate application forms to be collected from the college office. Apart from this, the boarders are to abide by the hostel rules strictly and any violation of these rules will lead to the expulsion from the Hostel and college as well.

3. COLLEGE MAGAZINE AND WALL-MAGAZINE:

The college under the aegis of students' union publishes a magazine JYOTISHMAN annually to explore the literary talents of the students. Apart from this each department has its own wall magazine.

4. GIRLS AND BOYS COMMON ROOM:

There are two separate common rooms for boys and girls. Newspaper, periodicals, and indoor games facilities are provided in the common room. Running water facility is available in both the common rooms and there is a vending machine in the girls' common room.

5. AUDITORIUM:

The college has an auditorium commemorating the memory of Prof. Rana Tamuly, erstwhile Vice-Principal of the college and a legendary comedian of Assamese films.

6. STUDENTS' UNION:

The college students' union is a general body of all students of the college and every student is a member of this union. Office bearers are elected annually through a general election among students.

7. GOLAGHAT COMMERCE COLLEGE CINE-THEATRICAL SOCIETY:

Golaghat Commerce College Cine-Theatrical Society is a body that caters to the students' need for developing their dramatic and cinematic interests.

8. INDOOR STADIUM AND SPORTS COMPLEX:

In order to inculcate the spirit of sportsmanship among the students, the college tries to provide indoor as well as outdoor sport facilities for the students. In College Indoor Stadium there are World-Class synthetic Badminton Courts, a Multi-Gym, Table Tennis Boards for students and teachers.

9. GCC FILM SOCIETY:

The college has a film society named GCC Film Society that takes initiative in screening different nationally and internationally acclaimed films and documentaries. The society is registered under Assam Film Society.

10. N.C.C.:

The college provides training in N.C.C. under the guidance of the following officers.

- a. N.C.C. Officer (Boys): Captain Dr. Devajit Dutta
- b. N.C.C. Officer (Girls): Lieutenant Mrs. Meghali Saikia

11. NSS:

The college has an NSS wing under Dibrugarh University which caters to the needs of the students in the field of social service. Co-ordinator- Mr. Biswajyoti Doley.

12. CANTEEN:

The college has a permanent refreshment facility for student as well as teachers named as Ajori Chora.

13. RED-RIBBON CLUB:

With the purpose of offering humanitarian service to the society, the Golaghat Commerce College has formed a voluntary blood-donation group comprising of the students of this college. The Red-Ribbon Club of the college is a body that works towards the control and prevention of HIV/AIDS through the participation of the students. The scheme is implemented with the support of the STATE AIDS CONTROL SOCIETY.

14. RESEARCH JOURNAL:

An international level peer-reviewed research journal (RESEARCH PROMOTER) is published annually to cater to the research needs of the students as well as faculty members.

15. LABORATORIES :

The college has laboratory facilities for the students particularly in the departments of Computer, Education, Geography and Language Laboratories for English, Hindi and Assamese. There is also a Soil Testing Laboratory in the college campus.

16. WOMEN CELL:

Golaghat Commerce College Women Cell aims at the advancement of women of the state of Assam in particular and women of the Northeast in general. Various dimensions of women and children's lives, such as status, education and training, health and nutrition, environment, housing, human rights are the focus areas of its activities. The cell is also carrying out research on the women related issues of the Northeast.

17. IQAC :

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been set up in the college to trigger action plans for quality evaluation, quality sustenance and quality upgradation of the institute. Accordingly, the cell has been making relentless efforts to motivate and guide the students, teachers and non-teaching staff of the college to achieve quality excellence.

18. ENTREPRENEURSHIP, CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CELL:

The college runs a career counseling and placement cell to help the students in planning and building their career. The sole aim of the cell is to INSPIRE, EXPLORE AND ACHIEVE. The placement cell is run by a group of teachers of the college. A good number of corporate houses conduct campus recruitment drives in the campus.

19. SCHOLARSHIPS:

Various scholarships are available in the college such as National Merit Scholarship, TGC, Sitaram Jindal Foundation (Delhi) and all other scholarships as awarded by the central and state government.

20. FACILITY CENTRE (Campus Needs):

The college runs a facility centre from which the students can procure their regular needs such as stationeries, uniform, text-books etc. The college also has Photostat facilities at subsidised rates.

21. DIGITAL CLASSROOM:

The college has a good 23 numbers of digital as well as smart classrooms for the benefits of the students.

22. ENVIRONER:

The college is very sensitive to the issue of worldwide environmental degradation and it sincerely believes that in order to address this serious issue

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the sensitization of the young generation is extremely important. With this primary aim in view the college has set up an environment awareness society with the nomenclature.

23. Day Care Centre:

The college runs a Day Care Centre in the campus with the objective of providing day care facilities to the children of college staff and visiting guests. The centre is equipped with essential infrastructure and play materials. A committee has been constituted to facilitate smooth functioning of the day care centre.

24. Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC):

Equal Opportunity Cell (EOC) has been established at Golaghat Commerce College to aid and advise the students belonging to marginalized sections including the Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Communities (OBCs), minority communities, Differently abled etc. pursuing various programs of studies in the College.

25. Mental Health, Wellness Counselling Centre:

The college has a Mental Health, Wellness and Counselling Centre which provides therapy and counseling services to students and staff. A Clinical Psychologist is available for counselling whenever required.

26. Restroom for Divyangjan:

Accessible toilets, restroom and other physical support facility such as ramps, walker is available for Differently Abled (Divyangjan) students.

27. Museum:

The College has developed a museum in the campus which showcase vibrant and colourful with cultural elements, heritage, physical features, etc. of the region. The museum is maintained by the Department of history.

28. Alumni Association:

The Alumni association offers networking opportunities which help fresh graduates to enter job markets.
