

To create awareness among students, the following steps were taken by the institute

1. **Orientation Programme:**

Freshers were briefed about the ill effects and legal consequences of ragging during the Induction/Orientation programme.

2. **Anti-Ragging Pledge:**

Both senior and junior students signed an anti-ragging declaration and pledged to maintain discipline and respect on campus.

3. **Posters & Notices:**

Posters, banners, and signboards displaying anti-ragging guidelines, helpline numbers, and punishments were placed in classrooms, corridors, and hostel areas.

4. **Workshops & Talks:**

The committee organized interactive sessions with counsellors, senior teachers, and legal experts to educate students on mutual respect and campus ethics.

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#### **4. Monitoring and Surveillance Measures**

To ensure strict vigilance, the committee adopted the following measures:

1. **Regular Rounds:**

Faculty members, wardens, and security staff made regular rounds in hostels, cafeterias, playgrounds, and other vulnerable areas.

2. **CCTV Surveillance:**

CCTV cameras were installed or updated in key locations to monitor student activity and discourage any form of ragging.

3. **Anti-Ragging Squad:**

A separate squad conducted surprise checks during peak hours, especially around the hostel premises and common spaces.

4. **Help-desk & Helplines:**

A 24×7 helpline number, along with an email address, was made available for students to report issues confidentially.

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## **5. Counselling and Support System**

The college counselling cell provided:

- **Emotional support** to freshers feeling anxious.
  - **Conflict resolution sessions** to handle minor disputes.
  - **Immediate support** to any student who reported discomfort or harassment.
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- **No cases of ragging were reported during the session, indicating the effectiveness of preventive measures.**

The Anti-Ragging Committee has implemented all possible preventive, monitoring, and corrective measures to ensure a safe, inclusive, and ragging-free campus.
